



## NATIONAL BR 30 RIMFIRE LEAGUE

Any licensed shooter may participate.

Targets may be shot at any participating branch or club.

Only "Official" SSAA BR30 targets may be used.

Targets do not need to be shot during shoulder to shoulder competition but must otherwise be shot under the official rules for BR30 Rimfire matches.

All targets must be dated and witnessed by the supervising range officer.

Competitors may shoot as many targets as they wish, but only one target (their highest scoring) will count each month.

Participating clubs will score targets as per the official BR30 rule book and forward the targets of their top three scoring shooters, and proficiency medal winners, to the League Convenor by the 7<sup>th</sup> of the month following the month in which the targets were shot. ie. Targets shot in April are only eligible for the April competition and must be in the hands of the League Convenor by the 7<sup>th</sup> of May.
